Talking of Blackman Park.....

The completion of Blackman Park is only weeks away, with the 2 new synthetic grass pitches, picket fences and light towers looking fantastic already! These new pitches will offer state-of-the-art all-weather surfaces for our Junior (U12+) and adult age-groups. No more wash-outs!

The new facilities will also open up opportunities for increased training hours, and NSFA competition games on Friday and possibly Saturday nights. NSFA's new Summer 6-a-Side competitions will also be run on these pitches.

Needless to say, we are lobbying NSFA to schedule as many of our 'home' games as possible on these fantastic new pitches.

Council and Lane Cove Scouts are also building a new Scouting and Amenities building at the east end of Blackman Park in 2015. We certainly look forward to improved storage, change facilities and amenities, as well as opportunities to use these facilities for football functions and activities as the need arises.



Development Squads and Coaching Initiatives for 2015

2015 will see an expanded and improved Development Squad programme for our MiniRoos and some Junior age-groups. There has been some hard work put in by our MiniRoos sub-committee over the past months, and we are really excited to make some announcements:

<u>Girls Diamond League</u>: In 2015, St Michael's Junior Football Club will be joining with Lane Cove FC to expand and develop the girls Diamond League programme. This will see teams in the U11 and U12 age-groups presenting the highest level of girl's junior football in the Lane Cove area.

<u>Development Squads</u>: Next year will also see an amalgamation of the St Michaels and Lane Cove FC Development Squad programmes for our U8, U9, U10, U11, U12 and U13 mixed teams. Bringing the very best players from each club together will provide a pathway through MiniRoos and into Junior football at the highest level – and all within Lane Cove!

The merged Diamond League and Development Squad programmes will be managed by a joint committee and administered by Lane Cove FC. Registration for the 2015 season will be through the normal Lane Cove FC on-line process. The programmes will provide:

- football opportunities for our younger players at the highest level within Lane Cove,
- · professional coaching,
- multiple coaching sessions per week

Meanwhile, our very popular Summer Skills programme will run again in Term 4 2014 and Term 1 2015, offering professional coaching opportunities to players of all levels in the U8 – U12 age-groups.

I am sure you will agree that these initiatives are a huge boost to local football, and will keep our younger players in the game, in Lane Cove and in our club through their junior years and into adult football!



MiniRoos Report

What an amazing 2014 season for all in the LCFC MiniRoos? Well done and thanks to all the volunteers, Coaches & Managers – we wouldn't have such an amazing club without YOU. Despite the shocking weather patterns and the lack of Gala Day and on-field activities at Pottery for club day, it was a rewarding and high-energy presentation session at our great friends Xago.

We have most of the kit and shirts in but if you do still have any items please contact the club as these items have to be purchased again and impact our registration costs. The final few games of the season were extremely rewarding for me, the level of passion and player progression this year was outstanding. I have a good feeling next year will be even bigger and better.

We are very pleased to be partnering with St Michaels FC for Development Squads (u8-u13) and Girls Diamond League (u11 and u12) for 2015. This gives us scale to compete with some of the bigger regional clubs that were historically attracting our players away and helps keep local kids playing locally. We have signed SoccerKickStart, junior coaching providers to the Western Sydney Wanderers, to be our coaches for both our combined Development Squads and our soon to go live Skills Development Sessions (10 week blocks).

We (StMFC and LCFC) recently ran a demonstration day on 8th October with SoccerKickStart. Over 90 kids attended and feedback was very positive about the coaches (great technically, organisationally and on discipline) and we aim to have between 1-2 development teams per age group from u8s to u13s as well as u11 and u12 Diamond League teams.

Our 2nd year of Skills Development Sessions (Term 4) 1-hour week, Tuesday and Thursday afternoons is kicking off and we have over 100 enrolments. Importantly in 2015 we look forward to further involvement from SoccerKickStart supporting our LCFC volunteer coaches for our regular teams helping us with implementation of on the field training to aid the kids of all ages and levels – LCFC is passionately committed to the development and enjoyment of all players.

Enjoy your summer, keep the World Game alive (ball and park is all that's needed) and we look forward to seeing you and your kids back at LCFC in early 2015
