This is for all age groups up to u12, with a particular focus on u7 as 2017 is their "entry year" to Development.

North Shore Lighting is a joint venture between Lane Cove FC, St Michaels FC and Chatswood SC, based at Blackman Park, and was set up by the clubs to give the more enthusiastic and talented players in the clubs a chance to have an "Development/Academy" type experience with their local friends, and without having to drive in peak hour to another suburb (Parent/Guardian self-interest is an important motivation!)
